The student division board

The Bureau, the core of the Student Division board, does plenty of paperwork and makes sure that everything that makes the Student Division tick works smoothly. The Bureau also convenes both the Student Division Meetings, where all the students of the division gather to vote about the future and economy of the division itself.



SAMO

Hi! My name is Christoffer and I'm the Student Division's SAMO which is the Student Safety and Welfare Representative. I'm a part of the board and if you have any concerns about your study environment or any other concerns about your wellbeing here at Chalmers you can contact me.



DAG

DAG is the Corporate Relations Committee and serves as the link between students and industry. Our mission is to provide students with a comprehensive overview of the numerous opportunities in the field. We achieve this by assisting companies with marketing and organizing events such as lunch seminars, pub events, and company visits.



DFoto

DFoto is the photography committee for the computer division. They take pictures at events arranged by its committees and upload them to DFoto.se! They are also the source of most of the photos in this module.



DNollK

DNollK is similar to DMNollK but arranges events for the new bachelor students.



DRust

DRust primarily maintains the student division headquarters, called Basen where you can find cooking equipment, vending machines among others. They also have tools that students can use if needed.



D6

The "sexmästeri" is the student committee that throws parties. The night club of Chalmers, called Gasquen, is situated in the student union building, Sometimes D6 arranges magical parties there and at other times they serve drinks at pub nights in Basen.



Delta

Delta is the PR association and is in charge of running the division's very own pub where there are lots of tasty beers of different alcohol levels as well as the delicious "Deltaburgers™ with cheese". They also organize ski trips and beer-chugging contests called "Häfv".



dHack

dHack is a committee whose aim is to keep the computer division's services up and running. dHack also occasionally arranges different activities to promote interest in technology, like a hackathon.



DLude

The computer divisions Ludologer devote themselves to games in all forms, digital as well as analog, long and short. They arrange game nights and LAN and sometimes cooperate with other student divisions to do tournaments, MTG drafts or days full of games.

iDrott is the association for all computer technologists who want to stay active in good company. They arrange sport activities, as well as putting together teams to represent the computer division in the prestigious Chalmers Championships in different sports. They also have sporting equipment you can borrow.



DKock

dBus

DNS also plays a major role in enhancing the education through evaluating courses to assess and improve teaching approaches and course content for the next year, as well as addressing long-term issues in order for the education to maintain its competitive position.



DatE-IT

DatE-IT is a labor fair aimed towards students studying in the fields of computer science and engineering, electrical engineering, software engineering, and medical engineering.

BakaD

BakaD is the baking committee. They hold events where the students get to bake something and sometimes they give away free baked goods in basen.

They also make sure the tea and coffee station in the kitchen is filled up and ready for any thirsty student



DBrus

DBrus is the division's podcasting committee. They release episodes slightly sporadically and the subjects vary wildly. The podcast is in Swedish so it is a good place to practice your understanding of Swedish



DLirium

The free press. DLirium investigates the juiciest stories and writes enlightening articles on them. The magazine is released every study period and if you want to practice your Swedish reading skills, give them a read.



Ståthållarämbetet

Talhenspresidiet

These are the people that lead the division meetings, the highest deciding organ in the division. Every study period the meeting is held and any member of the division is welcome.
